Menlo Manor & French Villa celebrated National Night Out with an All-American Theme this year.

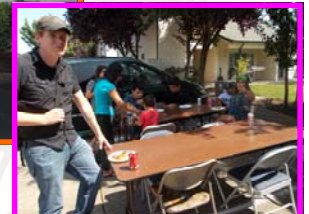
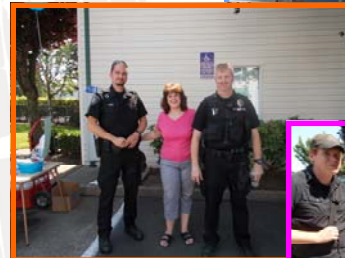
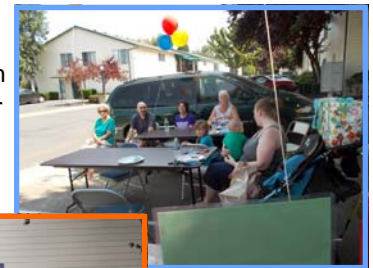

EMERALD POINTE

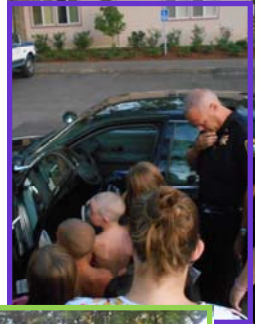

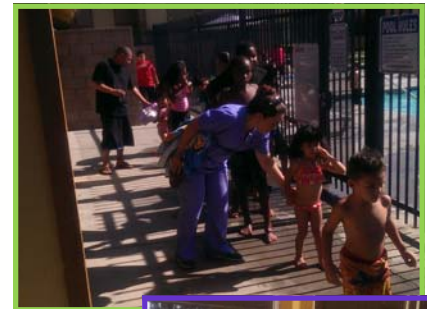
BRENT ARMS & COLE MANOR

THE HUNT CLUB

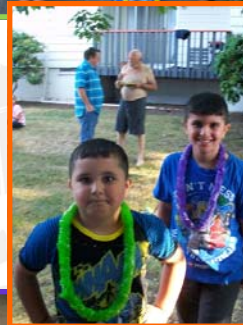
Everybody had a great time!! Especially the kids, This was a very big turnout 180+ people

It was great fun and a great opportunity to mingle with neighbors, meet new tenants, enjoy the pool area and get together as a community!

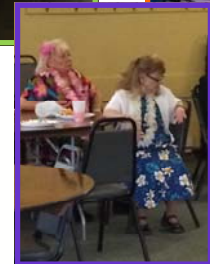

TRUCKEE PINES

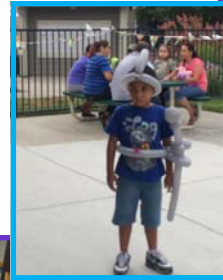

FAWNBROOK

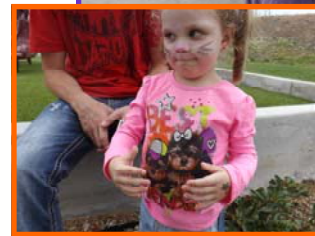

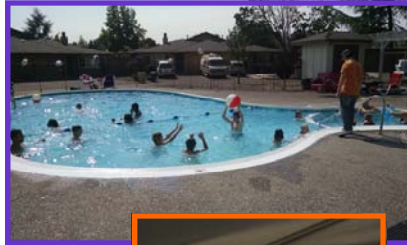

SUNRISE PARK

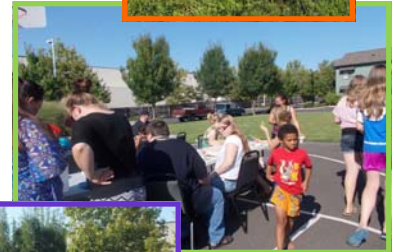
Sunrise Park's National Night Out was a great success. Our Residents loved our pool party. Residents bonded together in community awareness.

We love our residents at Sunrise Park!



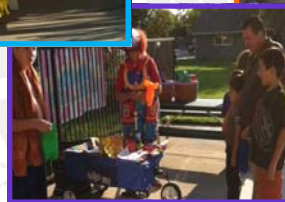
PRAIRIE VIEW

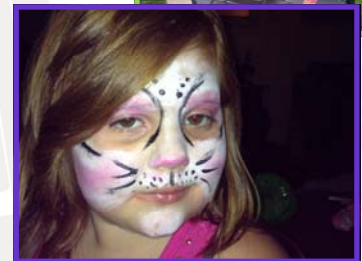
BOULDER CREEK
