May Rent Deferral Reminder

For those residents who might have paid rent in full during April but are now experiencing increased financial pressures, the **Defer Letter Form for May 2020**, emailed to all properties, can be used to communicate the amount of a rent deferral / partial payment that will help ease some of the financial pressures of the current economic conditions. Page 2 of the attachment is the turnaround document whereas page 1 is informational only.

Remember that in some states you can begin to fortify your file with documentation regarding the circumstances underlying the request for a deferral of some portion of rent for May 2020. There are other states where documentation can be requested but only at the time the resident chooses to bring current their past due rent balance.

Community Improvement Projects

Spring and summer months are normally the time to make community improvements. Below are some project reminders that may be currently put on hold and will need attention in the upcoming months. Please contact your supervisor to get approval prior to obtaining bids or beginning future work.

- Survey asphalt and concrete for signs of damage or trip hazards. Document and report damage to your supervisor, discuss proper remedies.
- Landscape maintenance, irrigation system repairs and improvements.
- Exterior touch-up painting.
- Exterior window washing.
- Freshen up parking lot and curb paint.
- Cleaning of common areas such as laundry rooms and clubhouses. Clean carpets and fresh paint are vital in our efforts to create a positive impression. When deep cleaning laundry rooms, remember to disconnect dryer vent hoses and clean them of all accumulated lint and debris.
- Property signage should be professional. It is a direct reflection of your property. Please take this time to review all signs on your property (any signs with the verbiage "No Soliciting" are strictly prohibited and must be removed immediately as it can be interpreted as discrimination).
