# Large Coin Deposit Preparation



# **Quick Reference Guide**

## How to prepare coin deposits

Please do not include checks or paper currency. The weight of any bag cannot exceed **50 pounds**.

- 1. Count and package the coin.
  - You may include a single or mixed denomination of coin in one bag.
  - For guidelines on estimating the value of non-mixed bags of coin, see the *Standard coin bag amounts and weight guidelines* section.
  - Coin bags are not returned.
- 2. On the deposit slip, include the following information:
  - Deposit date
  - Bag serial number(s)
  - Declared value of deposit
- 3. Package the deposit.
  - Keep the deposit slip outside the bag. Do not seal the deposit slip inside.
  - Complete all pertinent information in the bag's white spaces.
  - Load the coin into the bag, and seal the bag. Do **NOT** remove the processor receipt at the top of the bag.
  - **Note:** Do not attach the deposit slip to the clear plastic deposit bag or place it inside the bag as this will delay processing

#### **Deposit bag specifications:**

Material	Plastic (disposable)
Dimensions	10" x 19" to 12" x 24" (suggested)
Thickness	5 millimeters (minimum)
Color	Clear
Seal	Tamper-evident
Additional	Sequentially numbered, tear-off strip (customer receipt) including the bag serial number

### Tips for preparing your deposits

- Always keep the tear-off customer receipt that is preprinted with the bag serial number.
- On the outside of every deposit bag, write the following information:
- o Customer name
- Your location number (optional)
- o Deposit total (a declared value must be listed on each bag)
- $\circ$  Denomination (indicate denomination type or mixed-denomination).
- If deposit includes multiple bags, please number each bag sequentially and indicate the total number of bags (for example, Bag 1 of 3).
- You may deposit up to 10 bags of coin at once.
- Ensure all adhesive areas on the deposit bag are sealed.
- Ensure the declared value of the deposit is listed on the deposit slip.

#### Standard coin bag amounts and weight guidelines

Deposit contains	Standard full bag amount	Bag weight
Pennies	\$50	29.10 – 32.53 pounds
Nickels	\$200	42.24 – 44.60 pounds
Dimes	\$1,000	50.23 – 50.43 pounds
Quarters	\$1,000	49.76 – 50.00 pounds
Halves	\$1,000	49.60 – 49.90 pounds
Dollars	\$2,000	35.50 – 35.90 pounds

The weights listed are guidelines for estimating bag value; actual coin amount may vary. Count coins to verify deposit amount.
